

System of Controls for COVID-19 Safe Show-arounds

Thank you for choosing to visit our setting. We look forward to welcoming you to take a look around. In light of the current pandemic, we would like to make you aware of the system of controls we have in place to keep everybody involved safe before, during and after your visit.

We will ensure that:

- You have been offered the opportunity to view our virtual tour and speak with the Nursery Manager in charge as well as receive any additional information our setting can offer you virtually before arranging a physical visit.
- Any physical visits are organised in advance and outside of the setting's opening hours at a mutually convenient time for both the setting and yourself. At present we are not allowing existing parents or any non-essential visitors to enter the setting.
- Contact details are taken at the time of booking and checked on arrival for your visit for Test and Trace purposes. Please ensure you let us know if you or any member of your household develops symptoms of Coronavirus in the 48 hours following your visit.
- All visitors complete a risk assessment on arrival to the setting. Please do not visit the setting if you or any member of your household has symptoms of Coronavirus, has tested positive for Coronavirus or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive. Should you need to cancel an appointment, please contact the setting with as much notice as possible.
- Visits are concise and time slots are adhered to so that visits do not overlap. Only one family will be allowed into the setting at a time and we suggest asking as many questions as possible before your visit.
- Although the setting follows robust cleaning procedures throughout the day, all high contact surfaces are cleaned before and after each visit. Where possible please allow the member of staff showing you around to open and close doors.
- Face coverings are to be worn by all parties throughout the visit and social distancing is observed all times.
- All parties recognise the importance of handwashing before and after the visit and that antibacterial hand gel is used by all parties prior to beginning the tour and is available when leaving the setting.
